Thank you for attending our first Public Meeting about the funding we have secured to do an Initial Feasibility Study about the potential for Anaerobic Digestion in Kirkby Thore.

As I said the other night, Sustainable Energy Eden Ltd, is a company set up to benefit the local communities of the Heart of Eden through generating green energy. SEE is currently run entirely by volunteers and any profits SEE makes will go back to the local community.

As part of our plans to generate renewable energy, we are looking at a number of projects, including Solar Photovoltaic (PV) panels to generate electricity and the potential for an Anaerobic Digester (AD) to generate heat and electricity.
