## **2018/068 Outside Body Reports**

### **• Appleby Transport Group / Friends of the 563**

FB reported that the 563 service had been recently confirmed until the end of August. It is hoped that numbers using the service may increase during the tourism season and this may in turn encourage Stagecoach to put on an increased service. The 561 Appleby to Kendal service will cease in the next few weeks as usage was reported to have dropped by 40%.

The Settle / Carlisle railway has altered its timetable which is providing better connectivity with existing bus services. There will be no rail service on the 24<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> of May due to a rail strike.

## **2018/069 Highways Issues**

### **• Highways Agency Meeting 1**

The Parish Council attended a meeting with the Highways Agency. The agency wished to consult with the Parish Council on four separate short term initiatives for the A66. These included,

- Extension of the cycle path to end at approximately Low Moor
- Proposal to create a right turn lane into the filling station
- To create a turning lane west bound into Main Street from the A66
- To move the bus stop. Residents indicated that the shelter was used by students.

The causes of the recent accidents are still under investigation and therefore the Highway Agency was unable to give any more information about the incidents.

### **• Highways Agency Meeting 2**

Representatives of the Parish Council met with the Highways Agency in regard to the state of the carriageway on the A66 from Low Moor to just past the bridge in Kirkby Thore. The Highways Agency reported that the structure was faulted and might require the carriageway to be dug up to a depth of 2 feet. This work would require road closures. The proposal was to undertake the works at weekends for a period of 7 weeks probably starting in September.

There was a discussion held about dualling of the A66. There may be further updates on this following the 19<sup>th</sup> of June.
