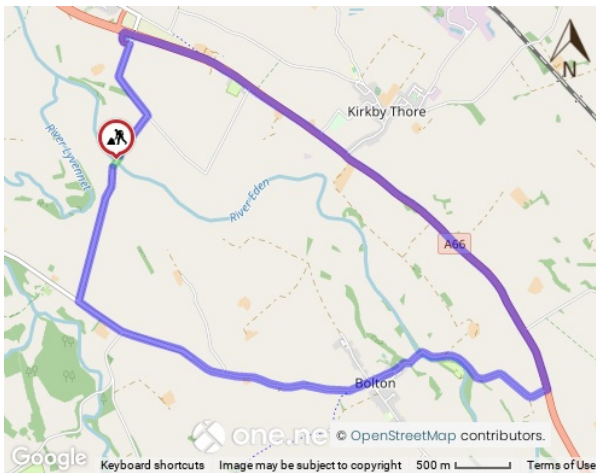
WEIGHT RESTRICTION (18T M.G.W)

C3057, OUSENSTAND BRIDGE, NR TEMPLE SOWERBY

Notice is hereby given, that because of the likelihood of danger to the public and potential damage to the bridge structure Cumbria County Council hereby prohibits any vehicle exceeding 18 tonnes maximum gross weight from proceeding along that section of the C3057 Ousenstand Bridge, nr Temple Sowerby for a distance of approx. 18m either side of the centre line of the bridge.

This notice will be in force for a period of up to 21 days from 17th May 2022, as and when the relevant signs are displayed. It is anticipated that the restriction will be required for 21 days. It is likely that after this time we will issue a second 21 day notice and if necessary, follow that with a Temporary 18 months Order.

A suitable alternative route for vehicles exceeding 18 tonnes maximum gross weight is available via the unrestricted section of the C3057, C3047 (Bolton) and the A66 (Kirkby Thore).



Nothing in this Notice shall:

1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform
